

The Symbolists retreated into the private realm of their emotions and imaginings, seeking to liberate art from its conventional descriptive role. Leading artists included Odile Redon, Gustave Moreau, Puvis de Chavannes and, outside France, Gustav Klimt, Aubrey Beardsley, Edvard Munch. An index of artists is included along with 56 colorplates and 263 B & W reproductions. A Very Fine collector quality copy.
